

My name is Carra and I will be team-teaching your child's class. I have been teaching ballet, gymnastics, tap, and jazz in the Atlanta area for over 28 years. I teach in a positive manner and reward the children for great behavior. I teach in a game form so the children are always having fun!

The classes I will be offering are tumbling tots, ballet, gymnastics, and jazz classes. Tumbling tot classes are offered for children ages 2 ½ years thru 3 years old. Ballet classes are offered for ages 3 thru 8 years old. Gymnastics classes are offered for children 3 thru 8 years old as well. Jazz classes are for children ages 6 and up.

Those children taking ballet classes will need the following items: a pink leotard, pink tights, and pink (LEATHER ONLY) ballet shoes. Gymnastics girls will need a leotard, and the boys will need a t-shirt and shorts or sweat pants. Jazz girls will need a leotard and black jazz shoes (LEATHER ONLY).

Payments will be made in three (3) different sessions. There is a yearly registration fee of \$25.00 per child.

BALLET, TUMBLING TOTS, & GYMNASTICS CLASSES:

SESSION 1:

All children will pay a non-refundable \$25.00 registration fee and \$135.00 for the first 11 classes. The first session will be held from August 30 thru November 15. **THERE WILL BE NO CLASS HELD ON SEPT. 20.**

SESSION 2:

The second payment will be due on November 15 for this session. This payment of \$135.00 will be for classes running from November 29 through February 28. **THERE WILL BE NO CLASSES HELD ON DEC. 27, JAN 3, AND FEB. 21.** All children who would like to be in the recital will have to pay a costume fee of \$60.00 on November 15. THE COSTUME FEE IS NON-REFUNDABLE.

SESSION 3:

The third payment of \$135.00 will be due on February 28. This session will run from March 7 through May 16. **THERE WILL BE NO CLASS ON APR. 4.**
